- **Rainnieshill Quarry:** - Application submitted, ref APP/2021/0546, advised by email on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2021 with request for response within 14 days of date of letter. UCC met with resident local to the Quarry site on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2021 (virtual meeting). Points of concern from residents were noted during the informative discussions. From those noted concerns and with consideration of the Applicants detailed submission the UCC prepared a response which indicated the

objection based upon the points of concern identified within the submitted.

- **Kirkwood B999/Ingleside Traffic Regulation Order**. Received 21<sup>st</sup> April 2021 with response requested by Noon of 21<sup>st</sup> May 2021. Response circulated and accepted by UCC members indicating our objection, citing reference taken from 95/0798/01 application at which the 'closure' of Ingleside had been determined on grounds of Road safety concerns. Response emailed on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021 as directed to [www.aberdeenshire.gov.uk](http://www.aberdeenshire.gov.uk). Acknowledgment of receipt and legibility requested.
- **Pitmedden News** - UCC submission deadline being 26<sup>th</sup> May 2021.
